Eligible applicants are invited to apply for library access and obtain a **Library Identification Card (Library ID).**

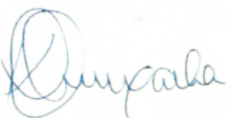
Eligibility Requirements

3. **Certificate of Good Conduct:** A valid police clearance certificate issued by the Federal Police Crime Investigation Bureau, confirming that the applicant has no criminal record.
